Citing Sources

Research writing demands that authors be credited for their work. Do not incorporate someone else's ideas or work into your article without citing the source. You must cite the source whenever you quote, paraphrase, summarize, or otherwise refer to the work of another person. The most common forms of citation are through the use of footnotes or endnotes, a works cited list, a reference list, or a bibliography in your article. Proper citation formatting can be found in the following books and many guides are available on the Internet.
